NOTIFICATION

Subject: POLICY FOR TRANSFER / POSTING AND POSTGRADUATE TRAINING FOR MOS/WMOS (BS-17) AND SMOS/SWMOS (BS-18)

In supersession of this department's Transfer/ Posting and Postgraduate Training policy dated 04.08.2022, the Competent Authority has been pleased to approve the following policy for the transfer/posting and for grant of Postgraduate Training in favour of Medical Officers/Women Medical Officers (BS-17) & Senior Medical Officers / Senior Women Medical Officers (BS-18):

1. Transfer / Posting:

- i. All fresh appointees of Punjab Public Service Commission will be posted in the DHQ Hospitals (Non-Teaching), THQ Hospitals, RHCs, BHUs, GRDs etc. across the province, except District Lahore.
- ii. All MOs/WMOs of PPSC Batch 2012 and earlier are eligible for transfer / posting in District Lahore / disposal of SH&ME Department, without any requirement of periphery service.
- iii. All MOs/WMOs of PPSC Batch 2013 and onwards are required to serve in the periphery i.e. DHQ Hospitals (Non-Teaching), THQ Hospitals, RHCs, BHUs, GRDs etc. for a period of 3-years, before they become eligible for transfer / posting in District Lahore / SH&ME Department.

2. Postgraduate Training:

- i. Those MOs/WMOs who have not served in the periphery for atleast two years, will be considered for grant of EOL (without pay) to undergo Postgraduate Training, as per the Revised Leave Rules, 1981.
- ii. Those MOs/WMOs who have completed atleast two years' periphery service will be considered for placement in teaching hospitals to undergo their Postgraduate Training, only, if the concerned training institution is ready to bear the expenditure of their salaries during deputation period.
- iii. In this regard, Postgraduate Training shall only be allowed in the Institutions functioning under the administrative control of the Federal Government, Provincial Governments, Armed Forces Medical Colleges and also in those Autonomous Institutions that are attached with any Government Department.
- iv. The above mentioned provision of policy regarding deputation / placement for PG Training will come into effect w.e.f. 31.12.2022.

1st Fellowship:

- i. 1st Fellowship includes FCPS, MD, MS, Diploma, M.Phil or equivalent qualification in relevant specialization.
- ii. All MOs/WMOs who have completed 1st Fellowship Training and have sanctioned posts in P&SHD will be posted in P&SHD. The specialties having sanctioned posts in P&SHD are as follows:

- iii. All MOs/WMOs who have completed 1st Fellowship Training and have no sanctioned posts in P&SHD will be transferred to SH&MED after passing exam, subject to provision of NOC from SH&MED.
- iv. The posts of specialties of 1st Fellowship Postgraduate Training which are not sanctioned in Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department are as follows, however, if a seat of these specialties is created in P&SHD in future that specialty will automatically be considered as deleted from the list:

4. 2nd Fellowship:

- i. 2nd Fellowship starts after passing 1st Fellowship and registered as specialist with PMC.
- ii. MOs/WMOs who are selected for 2nd Fellowship will be eligible for transfer to SH&MED, the details of 2nd Fellowship is as under:-

Miscellaneous:

- i. The period served in the Prisons / Jails, under the Home Department by MOs / WMOs / SWMOs / SMOs, may also be considered as periphery service except in District Lahore.
- ii. The requests for transfer / posting on wedlock basis will be treated as per provisions of this policy.
- iii. Upon promotion of MOs/WMOs to the rank of SMO/SWMO or equivalent, they will be allowed to continue to serve at their present places of posting subject to vacancy.
- iv. This policy is subject to revision by the Competent Authority.
